On September 5th, President Trump announced the end of DACA. He is allowing those who currently have DACA to keep their status until it expires. He is also allowing certain people to apply for renewal of DACA:

- No new INITIAL DACA applications can be submitted
- Those who have DACA will be allowed to keep their DACA status until it expires no matter the date
- If your DACA expires BEFORE March 5, 2018, you can still apply to renew your DACA, but YOU HAVE TO SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION BY OCTOBER 5, 2017!
- If your DACA expires AFTER March 5, 2018, you cannot submit a new DACA renewal application
- If your case is currently pending approval, it may be approved by USCIS but it is up to the discretion of USCIS

IF YOUR DACA EXPIRES BEFORE MARCH 5TH OF 2018 AND YOU HAVE NOT APPLIED FOR RENEWAL, COME TO THIS WORKSHOP ON SEPTEMBER 20th!!
